URGENT PC HIGHLIGHTED ON RICHMOND CBS AFFILIATE

RICHMOND, Va., September 17, 2008 - Uroplasty, Inc.'s (AMEX: UPI) Urgent[®] PC for treatment of the symptoms of overactive bladder was featured Monday on [Virginia This Morning](#), live on CBS 6 of Richmond.

Rosa Noyes, a patient at the Virginia Urology Center, discussed her frustration with overactive bladder and a lack of results from drugs, as well as the success brought by Urgent PC.

"I was using thick pads, morning and night," said Ms. Noyes. "I was going to the bathroom three or four times an hour, also getting up three and four times a night. I think I reached the point where I thought I had lost total control of my bladder."

Ms. Noyes said the benefits of drugs would wear off.

"I was pretty miserable," Ms. Noyes said.

Since then Dr. David Glazier of Virginia Urology recommended Urgent PC, which has provided Ms. Noyes with gratifying results.

The Urgent PC Neuromodulation System uses a hair-thin needle electrode inserted near the ankle. The stimulator's impulses travel along the tibial nerve to the nerves in the spine that control pelvic floor function.

Doctors Glazier and David Rapp of Virginia Urology demonstrated the device on Ms. Noyes during the live broadcast, resulting in calls into the station from interested viewers.

Ms. Noyes commented on how comfortable the treatment was.

"Sometimes I get a little tingle, but once it's in place and the procedure has started, I just socialize with the rest of the women," in the treatment room, she said.

With Urgent PC, Ms. Noyes said "Life is wonderful. I used to get into the car to leave town and I'd have to ask my husband to stop and we weren't even out of town, so, it's great, it's great."
